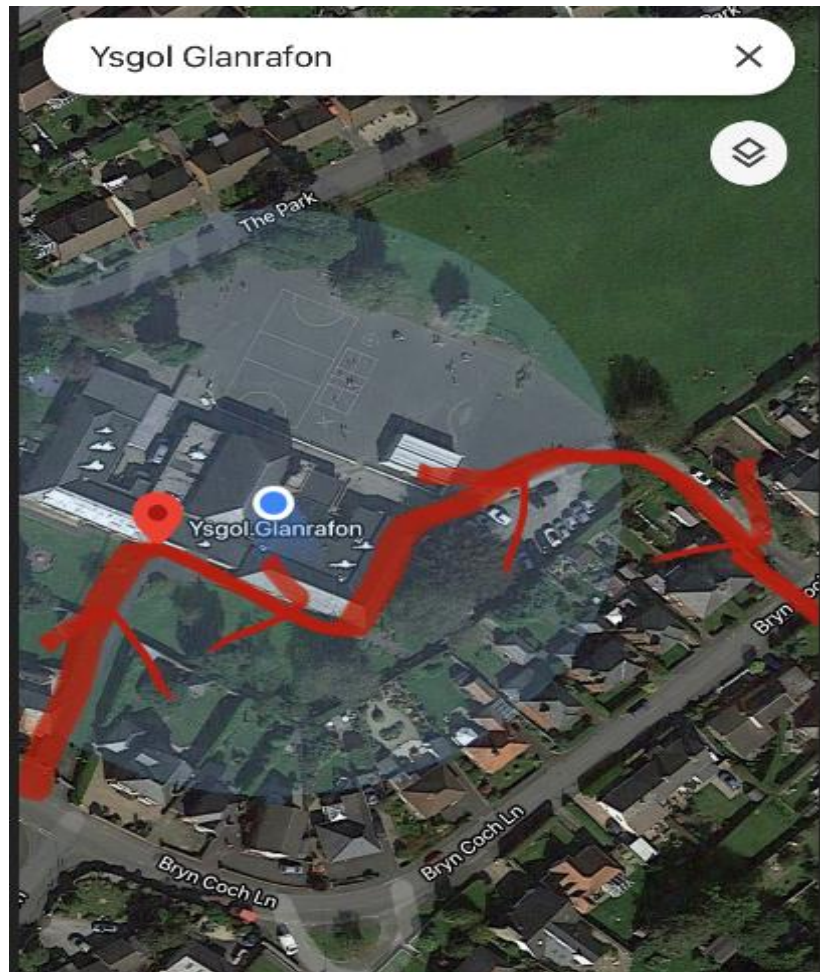


TREFNIADAU BEN BORE AC AR ÔL YSGOL – BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS.

Things are now moving very quickly with the building work for the extension, and we will need to adapt our arrangements as from **Monday, December 7th. onwards.**

From Monday onwards, a **one way system** will be adopted due to the building work and to ensure that the flow of the crowd will move in the same direction during the pandemic – with EVERYONE coming on to the site via the **top gate** at the front of the school.

The children travelling on the bus and taxis will continue with the present arrangements.

Arrive in the morning(8.45 tan 9.00)

The **Nursery and Reception** will be met by staff by the red gate outside the Under 7's Unit near the front of the school.



The **Years 1 and 2 pupils** will be met by the green gate at the top end of the Under 7's Unit's area. A stoned pathway has been laid in that area to avoid children from walking on the grass. Staff members will monitor that everyone come safely into school.



Years 3 and 4 pupils will continue to be met by staff at the main entrance.



Years 5 and 6 pupils will arrive via the top gate and enter the building through the usual door until the new entrance in Mr Rh. Jones' class is ready.

The older pupils can bring their siblings with them if this is more convenient to you. You are reminded that it is one adult only from each family that should come at the beginning and end of the day.



After leaving the children safely with the staff, everyone will then follow the one way system and move from the site along the side of the school and out through the big green gate(that will not be used by any vehicles by that time). Again, members of staff will monitor that entrance.

Leaving at the end of the day (FP – 2.55, KS 2 – 3.05)

Nursery pupils (finishing at 11.30 a.m.) and **Meithrin Plus** to come out through the main entrance and then follow the one way system.



In contrast to the morning, **Reception** parents are asked to collect the children from the Under 7's external area and to stand under the trees and on the tarmac nearby.



Years 1 and 2 to continue with the same arrangement as at present but to stand below the path please.



Years 3 and 4 will continue to come through the main entrance as at present. Parents are asked to wait for them in the same place as now and follow the one way system to leave the site.



Years 5 and 6 pupils will continue to come out through the same door as in the morning until the new door is ready, and leave by following the one way system
