Hwb Dysgu CA2 / KS2 Learning Hub



Following the announcement made by the Welsh Government last Friday, the Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2 pupils will be returning to school during the week following the half term holiday. Therefore, this means that KS2 pupils <u>will</u> <u>not be</u> returning at the moment – this will be revised at a later date.

The Learning Hub will be available for KS2 pupils (please see important note below and attachments from the Welsh Government) from Tuesday, February 23rd (In-Service Training Day on Monday, February 22nd) but there will be some changes due to the fact that the Foundation Phase are returning.

Welsh Government guidance states children of key workers should only attend school if there is absolutely no safe alternative, and only on days when their parent or parents are working.

Blended Learning will continue for KS2 pupils along with the Live Sessions. We hope to be able to organize more than one live session a week after half term.

IMPORTANT

- To book a place for the Learning Hub for the week beginning February 23rd, YOU MUST book a place on-line using our School Comms system by **midnight this Thursday, 11/2/21** please.
- We understand that your work commitments may change over the next few weeks, therefore if you are intending on using the Learning Hub for the first time, you must contact the office on postglanrafon@hwbcymru.net or the Deputy, Mrs Huws through email huwse@hwbcymru.net.

- To gain access to the Learning Hub, we will be asking for evidence of your employment as a key worker/key workers. (If you have provided this already, you do not need to present them again).
- Lunch arrangements will stay the same.

CHANGES

- The Learning Hub provision will now change to <u>8.45 tan 3.05</u> the usual school day time that was before Christmas.
- The Before and After School Clubs will re-commence and operate as usual, which means you will need to book and pay online for these as before.

Morning Club	7.30 – 8.30
Breakfast Club	8.30 – 9.00 (pupils must arrive before 8.45)
After School Club	3.00 – 5.45

- If you had already booked a place for your child for any of the Clubs since before Christmas, these bookings will be deleted and we will be beginning as new from Tuesday, February 23rd until Friday, March 26th.
- You are kindly asked to <u>ONLY</u> use the Free Breakfast Club if there is a <u>GENUINE NEED</u>. We will be monitoring this situation and ask you to be wise and considerate of those parents who are key workers who genuinely need the provision.
- The online booking system for the Learning Hub and Clubs will be open after mid-day today, Tuesday, February 9th.
- After half Term, Year 5 & 6 pupils who are attending the Hub will need to come through the new door in Mr Rhydian Jones' class, and Year 3 & 4 will need to come through the main entrance.
