DFN Project SEARCH is a one-year internship programme supporting young people with a learning disability to gain the skills and experience to move into paid employment.

A group of young people aged 18-25 are being recruited to work at Glan Clwyd Hospital Bodelwyddan, with the support of Agoriad Cyf, Betsi Cadwaladr UHB, Conwy and Denbighshire County Councils and Engage to Change.

The Engage to Change project is delivered in partnership between Learning Disability Wales, Agoriad Cyf, Cardiff University, and ELITE. It is funded by the National Lottery Community Fund and Welsh Government.

The key idea of DFN Project SEARCH is a partnership to bring together education, training and skills in a real life work environment. Supported by a tutor and job coach, interns will have the opportunity to try three different internships.

*Benefits of Project SEARCH to the interns*

- Participate in a variety of internships in a high-status local business
- Acquire competitive, transferable and marketable job skills
- Gain increased independence, confidence, self-esteem and a new friendship group
- Receive work-based individual instruction, coaching, support and feedback from the instructor, job coach and host business managers
- Develop links to adult support agencies

**We will be hosting two online information sessions via ZOOM where you can find out more about the project and how to take part.**

To be eligible to take part, you must be a young person aged between 18-25 with a learning disability living in Conwy or Denbighshire who is not currently in education, paid employment or training.
