Gofynnwn am gyfraniad gwirfoddol tuag at weithgareddau ac ymweliadau addysgol er mwyn cyfoethogi gwaith y dosbarth. Ni fyddwn yn gehardd unrhwy ddisgybl o weithgaredd os nad oes cyfraniad wedi'i dderbyn. Os nad oes digon o gyfraniadau gwirfoddol fe fydd rhaid i ni ohurio y weithgaredd.

Charging and remissions policy

We ask for a voluntary contribution from parents in order to organise activities and educational visits that enhance the work in class. No child will be excluded from activities if the contribution has not been paid. If we do not have enough voluntary contributions, then the activity may have to be cancelled.

If any activity means staying overnight e.g. Cardiff (Year 5), Glan Llyn (Year 4) the children from families who obtain income support or family credit, are entitled to be reimbursed for accommodation costs.

Curriculum for Wales

The Welsh Assembly is busy preparing school in Wales for a new curriculum due to be rolled out by September 2022. Schools in Wales are currently trialling out this new curriculum in preparation.

In delivering the new transformational curriculum, the focus will be on four key enabling objectives -

- ✓ Developing a high-quality education profession
- ✓ Inspirational leaders working collaboratively to raise standards
- ✓ Strong and inclusive schools committed to excellence, equity and wellbeing
- ✓ Robust assessment, evaluation and accountability arrangements supporting a self-improving system

It is their intention that learners will:

- ✓ benefit from experiences at school that will support them in becoming young adults that are:
- ✓ have relevant high-level digital, literacy and numeracy skills
- ✓ be increasingly bilingual with a strong grasp of other languages.

The new curriculum replaces existing key stages with 'progression steps', and will be organised into six Areas of Learning and Experience (AoLE) -

- ✓ Expressive arts;
- ✓ Mathematics and numeracy;
- ✓ Health and wellbeing;
- ✓ Languages, literacy and communication;
- ✓ Humanities;
- ✓ Science and technology.

Curriculum for Wales

The school is currently in a transitional phase where we are trialling out new approaches to teaching and learning in preparation for Curriculum for Wales 2022. This is a very exciting period for the school and we are excited to see what the curriculum may look like in the future.

Developing a transformational curriculum will be crucial to realising the vision for children and young people in Wales. They will have higher standards of literacy and numeracy, become more digitally and bilingually competent, and evolve into enterprising, creative and critical thinkers. The new curriculum will have equity and excellence at its core and help develop young people as confident, capable and caring citizens.

Our focus will continue to be on developing skills with the pupils.
One of the key documents we use is the Literacy and Numeracy Framework -

THE LITERACY AND NUMERACY FRAMEWORK- A PLANNING TOOL (LNF)

Through expectation statements, the LNF sets out the skills we expect learners to develop throughout their time in school, from ages 5 to 14, and is broken down into year groups. The LNF is split into components for literacy and numeracy, which are in turn split into strands.

The literacy strands are:

- ✓ Oracy across the curriculum,
- ✓ Reading across the curriculum,
- ✓ Writing across the curriculum.

The numeracy strands are:

- ✓ Developing numerical reasoning,
- ✓ Using number skills,
- ✓ Using measuring skills,
- ✓ Using data skills.

Each strand is further split into elements, with literacy also broken down into aspects. The literacy component is available in both English and Welsh. In addition to being a curriculum planning requirement, the LNF is also to be used by teachers for formative assessment. The LNF will be used to inform teachers' assessment of learners' literacy and numeracy skills and will be reported annually to parents/carers.

Foundation Phase

We believe in the following principles for our Foundation Phase children:



Early childhood education is valid in itself and should not be seen merely as a preparation for the next stage of learning.



Our provision for young children is holistic - the child is at the heart of any planned curriculum.

What children know and can do, their interests and what they understand is the starting point in their education.



A well planned curriculum is provided to ensure appropriate provision for children who are at an early stage of their development and for those who are ready, and more able, to move forward.



All staff are aware of the importance of understanding, inspiring and challenging children's potential for learning.



The young child's education is seen as an interaction between child and the environment, both indoors and out.



The adults and children to whom the child relates are of central importance to their development.



Young children learn best when they are happy and have opportunities to actively explore their environment, using all their senses.

Young children learn best through first-hand experience.

In the Federation we are committed to providing a meaningful, relevant, and motivating curriculum for our children, ensuring that we meet their specific needs and all-round development. Supporting us in achieving this is the Welsh Assembly Government's 'Framework for Children's Learning for 3 to 7 - year olds in Wales'. The statutory education programme is divided into six areas of learning which must complement each other and work together to provide a cross-curricular approach to form a practical relevant curriculum. Emphasis is placed on developing the children's skills across the areas of learning.

The six areas of learning are:

Personal and Social Development, Well-Being and Cultural Diversity (considered to be at the heart of the Foundation Phase)

Language, Literacy and Communication Skills

Mathematical Development

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Physical Development

Creative Development

Key Stage 2

All children from year 3 to 6 (Key stage 2) follow the programmes of study as laid down in the National Curriculum. The programmes of study and the National Literacy and Numeracy Framework are the basis of the school's schemes of work. Copies of these are available in school. The schools in the Federation give priority to **Literacy (English and Welsh) and Numeracy**, both of which are taught daily.

Science, History and Geography are taught as part of a topic framework. **Art and Design Technology** are linked into this framework where it is suitable. **Physical Education and Music** are taught as single subjects each week and linked whenever possible. **Information Technology** is used across all subjects. All topics are monitored, evaluated and reviewed as and when needed.

The school curriculum:

- ✓ Focuses on the learner;
- ✓ Ensures that appropriate skills development is woven throughout the curriculum;
- ✓ Offers reduced subject content with an increased focus on skills;
- ✓ Is flexible;
- ✓ Focuses on continuity and progression by building on the Foundation Phase and Key Stage 2;
- ✓ Is planned from the Literacy and Numeracy Framework;
- ✓ Continues to deliver a distinctive curriculum that is appropriate for Wales;
- ✓ Supports Government policy, including: bilingualism, Curriculum Cymreig/Wales, Europe and the World, equal opportunities, food and fitness, sustainable development and global citizenship, and the world of work and entrepreneurship.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR ACCESS TO CURRICULUM DOCUMENTS

Curriculum documents are available for your perusal on the federation website or from the school office.

The total teaching time per week as recommended by the Welsh Government is **21.5** hours for foundation phase pupils and **23.5** hours for junior children. The school exceeds these requirements. This does not include time for registration, collective worship, playtimes or lunchtime. A variety of teaching styles and methods are used and children will be taught as a class, group, or individually, depending upon their need and the curriculum studied. This has been flexible during COVID.

Mae'r ysgol hefyd yn ystyried disgyblion talentog neu sydd â gallu arbennig fel unigolion sydd ag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol. Rhoddir enw pob plentyn ag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol yn y Gofrestr A.D.Y. Yr ysgol sy'n gyfrifol am leoli plant ar y camau a nodir yng 'Nghod Ymarfer Anghenion Dysgu ychwanegol Cymru' ac am fonitro, adolygu ac am ddyrannu adnoddau ar eu cyfer o gyllid yr ysgol ac o'r arian a ddaw law yn llaw â lleoliad plentyn yn y cyfnodau hyn yn yr Archwiliad Blynnyddol. Yr Awdurdod sy'n gyfrifol am roi Datganiad Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol i blentyn. Mae'n bolisi gan yr ysgol i gysylltu â rhieni unrhyw blentyn pan fydd yn cael ei osod mewn unrhyw gyfnod a/neu cyn iddo gael ei gyfeirio am asesiad arferol neu statudol. Additional learning needs

Many Additional Learning Needs staff are employed to assist those pupils who have Additional Learning Needs. Individual attention or small group attention is given within the class by the class teacher as part of our universal provision, as well as input by the by the ALN Co-ordinator. If extra individual attention is required, the child is then referred to the County Psychological Service Department, where specialist provision could be arranged.

Additional learning needs policy

Our aim is to develop a comprehensive and detailed means of assessment in order to identify each pupil's specific needs and to devise a work schedule that is relevant to that pupil. The school also considers talented pupils or those with a special ability as individuals with Additional Learning Needs. Every child with Additional Education Needs is included in the Additional Needs Register. It is the school's responsibility to place children in the stages described in the 'Welsh Additional Learning Needs Code of Practice', and to monitor, review and allocate resources for this purpose out of the school budget and the funds which come with the placement of children in these stages in the Annual Review. It is the Authority's responsibility to provide a child with a Statement of Additional Educational Needs. It is the school's policy to consult with parents when a child is placed in any stage and/or referred for a usual or statutory assessment. We keep parents fully informed of any improvement in the child, and they are invited to every review. A full copy of the Additional Learning Needs policy can be seen at the school.

We are currently making good progress toward the new code which will be statutory from September 2021.

There will be no more than 10 in the provision.


The provision is for general and moderate learning difficulties. These pupils may have associated difficulties which may include speech, language, communication, behaviour, emotional and social difficulties.

Sex and relationships policy

Sex and relationships education is linked with requirements within the Curriculum, and use is made of the SENSE program. Personal and Social Education and wellbeing has a prominent part in the school. The pupils learn about 'oneself' - how the body functions, the senses, feelings and respect for oneself and others. When these aspects are introduced to the children, great emphasis is placed on the importance of moral values and love. The school's Sex and Relationships Policy is available in school.

Religious education

Religious Education is part of a process to help children and young people to understand the world and enable them to adapt to its various needs. Religious Education should enable each child to -

- gather information and understanding of various religious beliefs and practices,
- appreciate the religious perspective when discussing contemporary and moral issues,
- develop the ability to form an opinion and be aware of the qualities required to make life purposeful.

Parents have the right to have their children excused from these lessons if it goes against their beliefs, but this should be done formally to the headteacher in a written statement.

Admissions policy

Pupils are admitted to the Nursery in the school year they attain their fourth birthday. Five sessions a week are offered from 9.00- 11.30 a.m. daily.

In the summer term before the Nursery children start, parents are invited to obtain information, to see the unit and to meet the members of staff and to discuss the arrangements for the coming year.

In accordance to the requirements of the Foundation Phase, the Nursery and Reception classes work together as an Early Years Unit each morning. The emphasis in the Foundation Phase is placed upon learning through experience and offering the pupils innovative experiences which are relevant to their needs. Each child's progress is carefully monitored.



Defnydd o'r Gymraeg

Welsh is the main medium of education at Ysgol Glanrafon – each child is expected to be bilingual by the time he/she leaves the school. We are proud of the fact that the pupils show pride in the Welsh language and the Welsh heritage. School has attained the gold status of the Language Charter.

Addysg Gorfforol

NODAU'R YSGOL AR GYFER CHWARAEON

Mae pwyslais mawr yn yr ysgol ar annog yr holl disgyblion i ddatblygu ffitrwydd. Rydym yn gwneud hyn trwy gyfrwng y gwersi lechyd a lles, Addysg Gorfforol a Chwaraeon ynghyd â chystadlaethau a thwrnamentau o bob math.

Cynhelir amrywiol glybiau chwaraeon yn wythnosol. Ceir cyflenwad o offer a ddefnyddir gan y disgyblion ar amseroedd chwarae, ac mae'r ysgol wedi buddsoddi'n eang i sicrhau offer dringo a ffitrwydd ar gyfer yr holl ddisgyblion ar gyfer amseroedd chwarae.

Bydd y gwersi gymnasteg, symud a dawns yn digwydd yn neuadd yr ysgol - a hynny yn droednoeth. Bydd gweithgareddau megis sgiliau pêl-droed, pêl-rwyd, rygbi, hoci, athletau a.y.y.b. yn cael eu cyflawni tu allan. Caiff disgyblion Cyfnod Allweddol 2 gyfle i dderbyn hyfforddiant mewn nofio yn eu tro a'r nod yw sicrhau y bydd bob plentyn yn medru nofio o leiaf 25m erbyn y byddant yn symud ymlaen i addysg uwchradd.

Physical Education

SCHOOL'S AIMS FOR GAMES

There is an emphasis in this school to encourage pupils to maintain fitness. This is done through Health and well being lessons, Physical Education lessons and sports activities and sporting competitions. Various sporting clubs are held on a weekly basis.

Various resources are used by the pupils during play times, and school has invested in the purchase of good quality fitness and climbing equipment for all the pupils to use at playtimes.

The gymnastics, dance and movement sessions are held barefooted in the school's hall, whilst activities such as football, netball, rugby, hockey, athletics etc. are held outside. Key Stage 2 pupils receive tuition in swimming in their turn and the aim is that every child is able to swim at least 25m. by the time they move on to secondary education.

Health and safety arrangements

HEALTH AND SAFETY ARRANGEMENTS

Every possible care is taken to ensure children's safety whilst they are at the school. If a child is taken ill, or involved in an accident, the parents are contacted and, if needed, the child will then be taken to the Casualty Department at Hospital. Medicine will be administered to children in special instances and on the receipt of written instructions from the parent.

No child is allowed to leave the school without permission. If there is a change to normal arrangements, the parents are requested to inform the Headteacher or the child's class teacher in advance.

The school regularly reviews health and safety arrangements for pupils and staff. Every visitor must visit the main entrance before gaining access to the school. Visitors are given an identification card. If a visitor acts inappropriately towards a pupil or member of staff then they will be asked to leave the school campus immediately and the police informed if needed. The school has a burglar alarm system and fire drills are held termly.

Attendance

The pupils are expected to attend school regularly and punctually.

If this is found to be lacking the school will work with the family to support with the local educational social worker designated to this school. Please let us know if your child is going to be absent. School will contact the home, and any uninformed absence is regarded as an unauthorised one.

ILLNESS

It is hoped that every child will enjoy good health during their time at the school. If at any time your child feels unwell in the morning before school time, you are kindly asked not to send him/her to school on that day in order to avoid any discomfort for the child and also to avoid spreading the germs to other pupils. Can you please let us know immediately if there are any changes to your phone numbers.

MEDICINES AND TABLETS

We do not encourage medicines and tablets to be brought into school for safety reasons. It would be preferable for parents to administer the prescribed medicine personally at home or in school. In exceptional cases only, parents should contact the headteacher in order to discuss the situation and to fill in a form to give written permission for the administering of the medication, if there is no other option.

We believe that the best way to nurture good behaviour is in a happy environment where children are able to give of their best inside and outside the classroom and where they are encouraged to reach their full potential.

Every pupils' aspect of good behaviour and attitude are rewarded with dojo points with the intention that every pupil gains as many dojo points as possible which enable them to receive further rewards at various times.

You are asked to pay for dinners on the internet using the School Gateway system. Everyone need to register in order to use this system. The cost of school dinners is £2.30 per day for all children.

Your child may bring sandwiches and a drink. Please ensure that they are carried in unbreakable containers. You are asked not to include any packs of nuts in packed lunches please.

You may be entitled to free school meals. The necessary forms are available in the school, so please don't hesitate to ask for one.

Healthy foods

It is only fresh fruit or raw vegetables that pupils are to eat during the morning break time. Your support in promoting the school as a healthy eating school will be much appreciated. We ask that you provide healthy snacks for play-times.

The children need to bring a bottle (not glass) of water with them into class to drink as and when required during the day. They are asked to take the bottle home in the afternoon and return it in the morning. The children may bring another drink with them for the playtimes. Three water machines are conveniently located in the school.
